

Smokefree Housing Laws by the NUMBERS (California)

- 23** Cities/counties that require at least 75% of contiguous units in apartments be non-smoking
- 12** Cities/counties that require 100% of both apartments and condos be non-smoking: Belmont, Richmond, Sebastopol, Santa Clara County unincorporated, Pasadena, Sonoma County unincorporated, Compton, Alameda (city), Huntington Park, San Rafael, Petaluma, Walnut Creek

1.2 M People living in cities with 100% existing in-unit smokefree requirements

Nonsmoking – 100% of New Units built after ordinance adoption	3 Contra Costa County unincorporated areas (4-unit apts & condos – Jan 2011), Pinole (May 2010), Pleasant Hill (apts Jan 2011)
Nonsmoking Common Areas (Indoor and Outdoor)	1 Alameda, Albany, Berkeley, Dublin, Emeryville, Fremont, Oakland, Union City, Contra Costa 4 County unincorporated, Pinole, Pleasant Hill, Richmond, Martinez, San Ramon, Walnut Creek
Disclosure of smoking areas and rules	8 Albany, Dublin (apartments only), Fremont, Oakland, Contra Costa County unincorporated, Pleasant Hill, Richmond, Martinez
Nuisance Designation for Secondhand tobacco smoke	6 Dublin, Fremont, San Leandro, Union City, Martinez, Pleasant Hill
Non-smoking Common Areas – INDOOR only	6 Livermore, Newark, Pleasanton, San Leandro, Alameda County unincorporated, San Ramon
Housing Authorities with 100% non-smoking units policies	2 Alameda (city), Pleasanton
No smoking on all private balconies, decks, ONLY (no existing in-unit restrictions)	3 Martinez (4 unit + apts and condos), Contra Costa County unincorporated areas (4 unit+ apts and condos), San Ramon
No Smoking within 25 feet of any entrance, exit, operable window or air intake of a neighboring single family home	1 San Ramon
