E2/M2 dispatched at 1840 to the [REDACTED] of an apartment complex for a [REDACTED]. Crews were directed by Command 12 to stage in quarters due to protest activity in the immediate area of the call. It was reported to the crews a large group of protestors were within a block of the call and the medical response were to stage in quarters until a police escort could escort us to the call. While waiting we were given periodic updates [REDACTED] through our MDT. At 1840 [REDACTED]. At 1849 [REDACTED]. At 1855 [REDACTED]. At 1903 [REDACTED]. At 1903 a BPD crew arrived at Station 2 and escorted us to the call. BPD stayed on scene for protection. Pt was found [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] pt quickly brought to ambulance due to protest getting closer. Slight delay on scene due [REDACTED] extrication of patient. While in front of building prior to transport [REDACTED], multiple police officers were on scene protecting EMS crews and BFD BC was on scene stating immediate transport needed due to volatile protest and scene safety. Pt was transported C3 [REDACTED] with three paramedics providing patient care. [REDACTED] was achieved after arrival [REDACTED]. When ambulance crew left [REDACTED].

Dear Mr. Riggs, Chief Dong and Chief Webb:

Pursuant to my rights under the California Public Records Act (Government Code Section 6250 et seq.), I ask to obtain a copy of the following, which I understand to be held by your agency:

* A general description of the Dec. 7 medical call in the 2100 block of Kittredge Street ("time out 1841" on the scanner recordings) including: the request for aid as it came in to dispatchers, the time the call came in, the time it was dispatched, the time on scene, the time leaving the scene, the hospital arrival time and the time of death, whether life-saving measures were provided at any point while BFD was involved. Further, I am seeking information on what type of police assistance was provided, and when, whether there were protest related activities that delayed the response and what those were.

* If there is a specific report available about this call, I would also like to receive a copy. Any information about the identity of the subject can be freely removed, as I am not interested in that, but only the logistics of the call and how the protest impacted it.

* If possible, my preference would be to receive these materials electronically, as a PDF or in email.

I ask for a determination on this request within 10 days of your receipt of it, and an even prompter reply if you can make that determination without having to review the record[s] in question.

I would not ordinarily trouble you with this written request, but when I first made it informally I was told by Chief Dong that your agency considers the information to be exempt from disclosure because of HIPPA. I respectfully suggest that this position, if I understand it correctly, is inconsistent with the Public Records Act.

If you determine that any or all of the information qualifies for an exemption from disclosure, I ask you to note whether, as is normally the case under the Act, the exemption is discretionary, and if so whether it is necessary in this case to exercise your discretion to withhold the information.

If you determine that some but not all of the information is exempt from disclosure and that you intend to withhold it, I ask that you redact it for the time being and make the rest available as requested.

In any event, please provide a signed notification citing the legal authorities on which you rely if you determine that any or all of the information is exempt and will not be disclosed.

If I can provide any clarification that will help expedite your attention to my request, please contact me at 510-459-8325. I ask that you notify me of any duplication costs exceeding \$50 before you duplicate the records so that I may decide which records I want copied.

Thank you for your time and attention to this matter.
