INCIDENT SUMMARY

On July 30, 2020, at approx. 2118 hours, Ofc. Miller was parked on the 1400 block of Shattuck Ave in the vicinity of Safeway and CVS. Ofc. Miller heard a commotion coming from the parking lot of CVS. Believing that there may have been a crime in progress, she drove from her location near Safeway into the CVS lot. Upon her arrival, Ofc. Miller challenged a male suspect (later identified as Brandon Owens) and a female suspect at gun point. Another female suspect was already inside of a parked blue Ford Fusion. The female suspect got into the car. During Ofc. Miller's contact with Owens, she directed Owens to get into the car. Owens complied. Ofc. Miller directed Owens to put the keys to the car on top of the car. Owens appeared to comply, placing some keys on the roof of the car. Owens subsequently started the car. Ofc. Miller gave commands for Owens to turn off the vehicle. Owens did not comply, instead pulling first forward slightly in the space, then turning and backing the car up within the parking space, ultimately angling it slightly to point north and east. Ofc. Miller continued to command Owens to turn the car off and moved towards the vehicle.

Owens disregarded her commands, and turned the car, moving forward, in a northbound turning maneuver, finally accelerating and driving north, onto and over the raised parking median, and passing Ofc. Miller.

Ofc. Miller discharged her service firearm three times in the direction of the left front area of the moving vehicle as it drove past her. The vehicle fled the parking lot.

ALLEGATIONS: This investigation is to assess if Ofc. Miller violated General Order U-2 (Use of Force) and General Order V-6 (Vehicle Pursuits) when she discharged her firearm.
