SECOND COUNT

The Undersigned further deposes and says on Information and belief, that said ROBERT BRIGGS did, in the County of Alameda, State of California, on or about February 11, 2010, commit a Felony, to wit: ASSAULT WITH DEADLY WEAPON, a violation of section 245(a)(1) of the PENAL CODE of California, in that said defendant(s) did willfully and unlawfully commit an assault upon MICHAEL MAYFIELD with a deadly weapon, to wit: pipe, and by means of force likely to produce great bodily injury.


